Both had early desires of making wine and spent most of their lives doing so. The year 2012, however, marked the first vintage that they produced together. Previously, during the grape harvest, Bibiana and Jeff were like the proverbial ships passing in the night. Early grape picks and late nights at the winery left them rarely crossing paths. Now, they do cross paths and bring you 2 Sauvignon Blancs, one in homage to the great whites of Bordeaux and the other of the Loire.

1860 in Ludes, Victor Canard, A cooper, and Léonie Duchêne, from a family of "vignerons" met and fell in love. They got married, and started to make their own champagne. Success came quickly, so they then decided to set up their own Champagne house. They joined their names together, in the true Champagne tradition, and Canard-Duchêne was born. The year was 1868.

The Third generation continues on the same tracks. Since 1930, Victor Canard, the founder's grandson, gives a new life to the label. From the 300 "crus" in the Champagne region, Canard-Duchêne has chosen 60 of them, blending Pinots and Chardonnay, in order to create year after year fruity, balanced and rounded wines.

Seña wine was established as a collaborative venture in Chile between Viña Errázuriz and Robert Mondavi. Since 2005, Señá has been owned by the Chadwick family, proprietors of Errázuriz, and is the personal project of Eduardo Chadwick.

Eduardo's ambition is to create a Chilean icon wine, one which fully expresses the terroir. The inaugural vintage of Señá, which is Spanish for distinguishing mark or personal signature, was that of 1995. The wine is made from a blend of six of the classic red grape varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Carmenère, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec. The grapes for Señá are sourced from Señá Hillside vineyards within the Aconcagua Valley, in which vines are grown according to bio-dynamic principles.




BARREL ROAD

Giò (pronounced "joe") is short for *giovane*, the Italian word for young. These wines are made to be enjoyed on release wherever there is good food and even better company. With exceptional balance and a flavor profile characteristic of the *delle Venezie* and Veneto regions, these wines are lovingly crafted by a group of local winegrowers whose collaboration dates back to 1948 and today helps support 1300 families. They are farmers first and take extraordinary pride in the land and vineyards behind Giò.

GLAETZER



The first Glaetzers settled in the Barossa Valley in 1888 after emigrating from Brandenburg, Germany, bringing with them a passion for winemaking. Over a century later, winemaking patriarch Colin Glaetzer established Glaetzer Wines. From the warm, northern district of Ebenezer in the Barossa Valley, Shiraz vines up to 130-years-old produce concentrated grapes with depth of flavor and complexity. Ben Glaetzer, son of Colin, heads up the winemaking team today. He is committed to expressing the purity of fruit; using minimal intervention techniques, Ben produces ultra-premium wines that are unmistakably Barossan, yet markedly elegant.

OREGON WINE TRAILS



In the 1830s, rugged explorers traveled west on the Oregon Trail. After months of treacherous voyaging, they were rewarded with the fertile hills of the Willamette Valley – the geological history of the land reveals rich deposits of marine sediment and volcanic soil.
